

EMS Young Scientist Award 2009



The **Young Scientist Award** is presented annually to acknowledge excellence in young scientists. This award includes 1000€ and the reimbursement of travel expenses of the awardee to attend the EMS Annual Meeting.

Eligibility

Young scientists working and/or studying in a European country are eligible for the award. All countries with an EMS Member Society or included in the WMO RA VI region are considered as European. For a country overview please consult the EMS Web Site at: www.emetsoc.org/about_ems/member_societies.php. Candidates shall be under 35 years of age on the first of January 2009.

Requirements

The candidate must have written a high quality publication in a reviewed international scientific journal, or an outstanding PhD thesis. The paper shall have been published during the three years that precede the nomination.

The following bodies may **recommend candidates**:

- (i) any EMS Member Society or EMS Associate Member
- (ii) the EMS Awards Committee.

Each of the aforementioned bodies may nominate up to two candidates.

Documentation

In order to qualify for the Young Scientist Award the following documents are required:

- (i) a short curriculum vitae,
- (ii) a document to determine the age of the candidate,
- (iii) a supporting statement (e.g. by an EMS Member Society or an EMS Associate Member),
- (iv) a copy of the proposed paper or PhD thesis in English. If a PhD thesis is not available in English, a publication based on this thesis in a reviewed journal (in English) is requested.

The Award will be presented during the Opening Session of the 9th EMS Annual Meeting & 9th ECAM in Toulouse, France, on 28 September 2009.
