

# EUROPHOTOMETEO'12

The European Meteorological Society (EMS) announces the Photography Competition *EUROPHOTOMETEO'12*, with the terms and conditions described below.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### 1. Contestants

The competition is open to any person that would like to participate. The maximum number of photos allowed by each author is three.

### 2. Topic & Time Period

Only digital photos specifically related to meteorology and with EXIF properties that prove that they were taken within 2010 or 2011 will be accepted.

### 3. Uploading and deadline

All photos must be uploaded to the EMS photo gallery at [www.emetsoc.org/europhotometeo-12](http://www.emetsoc.org/europhotometeo-12). Registration with the author's full name and address is required. A title and a short description for each of the photos in English, maximum 120 words per picture, information on the original resolution (in pixels), equipment used, and the place and date where the photos were taken is required.

- photos need to be uploaded in jpg-format
- minimum width and height: 600 pixels
- maximum width and height: 2000 pixels
- maximum file size of 2 MB

The deadline for registration and upload of photos is 31 January 2012, 24h CET.

### 4. Admission

The Organizing Committee will decide which of the received photos will be admitted to the Contest. Subsequently admitted photos will be displayed at the photo gallery on the EMS web site.

### 5. Panel of Judges

The Competition Jury will consist of members of the EMS Council and the Presidents of the EMS Member Societies.

The Jury's decision will be final, and will not be subject to review.

### 6. Results and Prizes

The top ten ranked photos of the Competition will be displayed at the EMS photo gallery after 31 March 2012. Authors of the photos awarded a prize will be notified by e-mail.

The authors of the photos ranked first, second and third will receive 1000, 500, and 250 Euro, respectively, as well as a Certificate. The authors of the top ten photos will receive a printed copy of their selected photo.

### 7. ADDITIONAL NOTES

Authors will keep the intellectual property rights, but will give EMS and its Member Societies the rights to publish any submitted photo on the EMS web site, and use them in electronic and printed form in EMS and EMS Member Society literature as well as in exhibitions, with no payment being made for the use of the copyright whilst always acknowledging the author of a photo.

By uploading their photos to the EMS photo gallery, the authors agree to these terms and conditions as well as the decisions the organizers may take about any other matters, at their discretion.
