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Participation to the conference:

From Monday 3 September 2018 to Friday 7 September 2018

Motivation:

As PhD student, it is important to take part to conferences and international meetings. In particular, I decided to take part to the EMS annual meeting 2018 as it is the only large European meeting where an entire session is devoted to "wind gust" – my main research focus.
