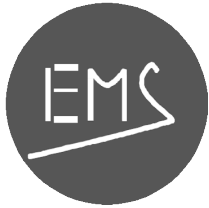

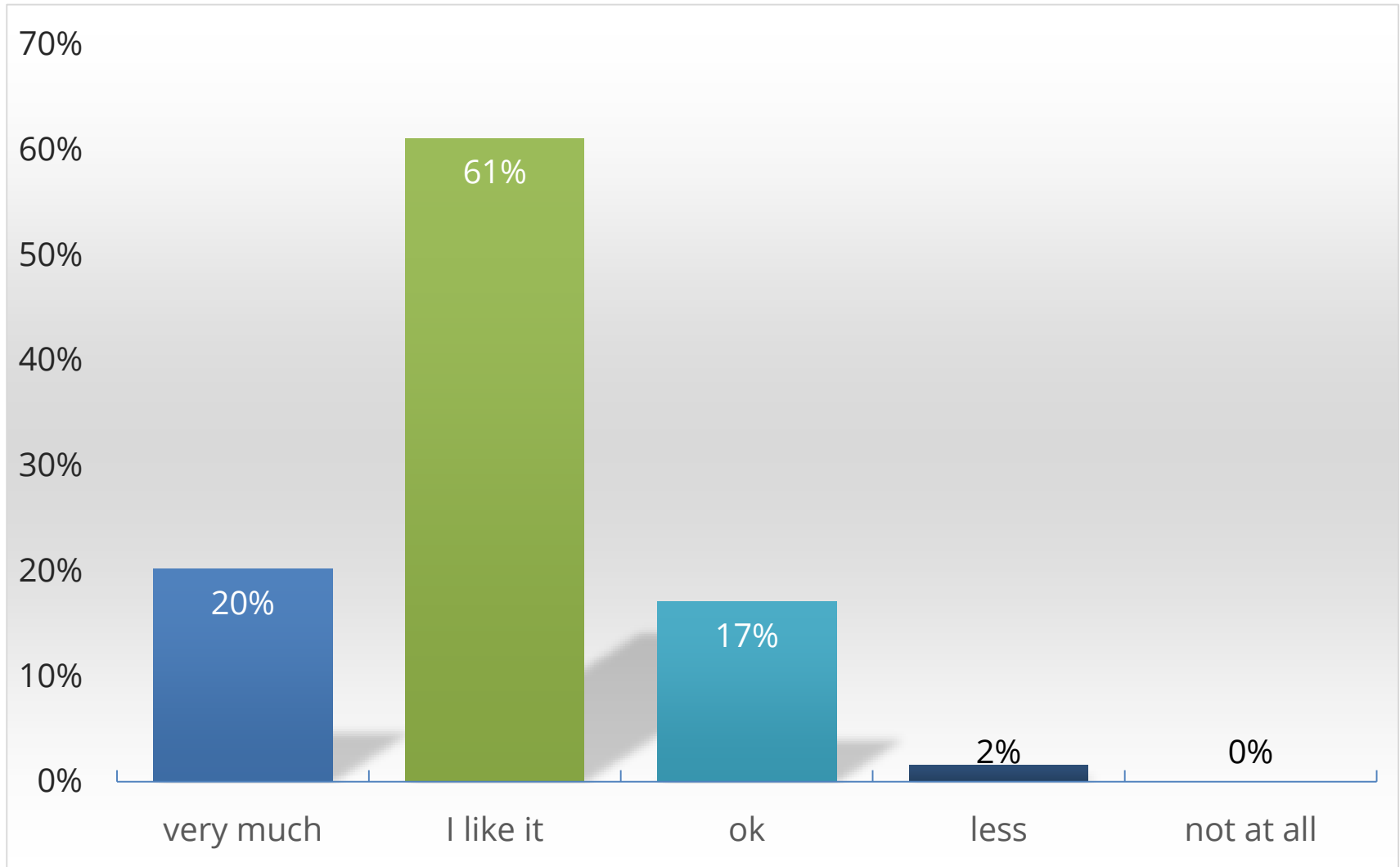

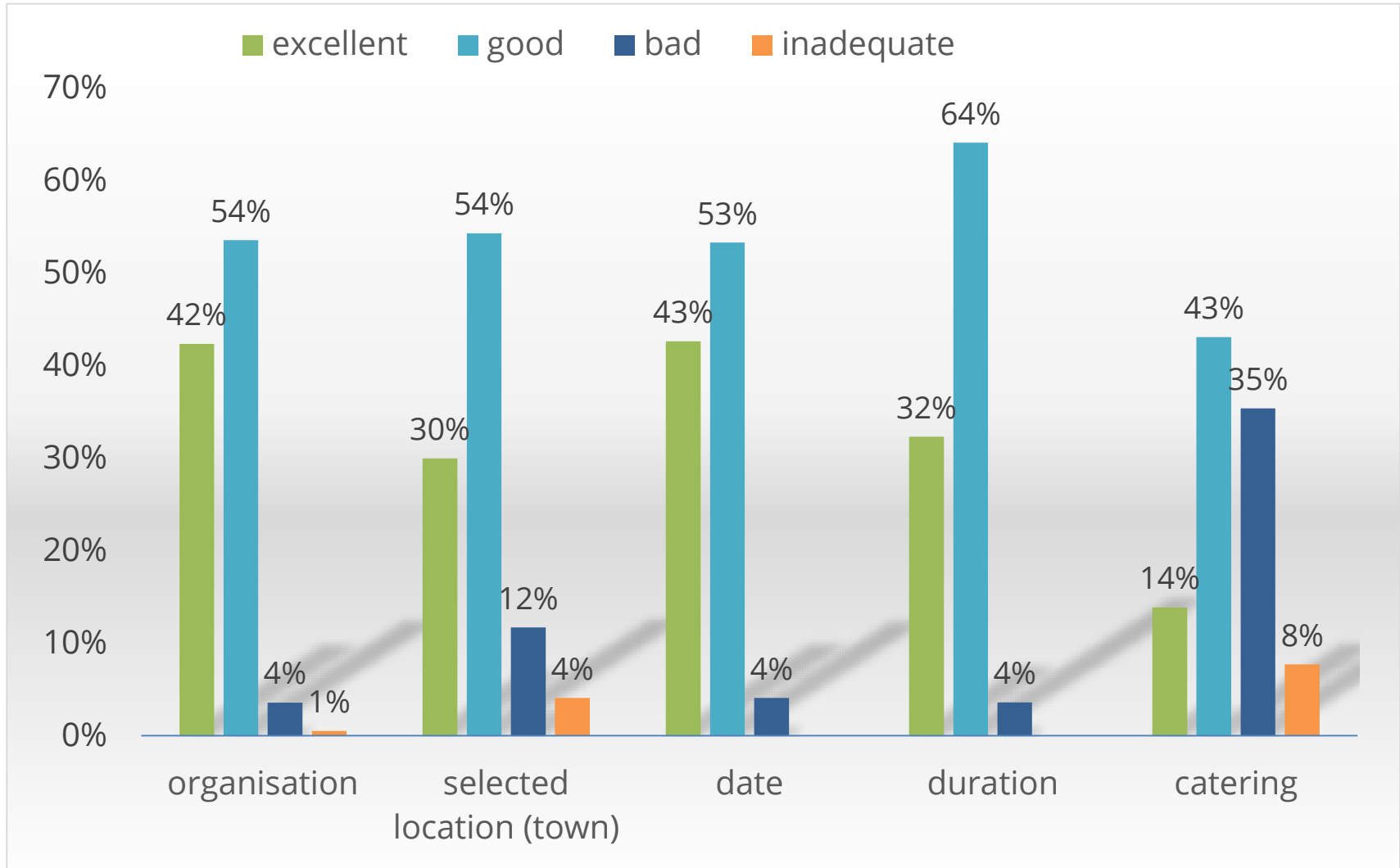


How did you like the event in general?



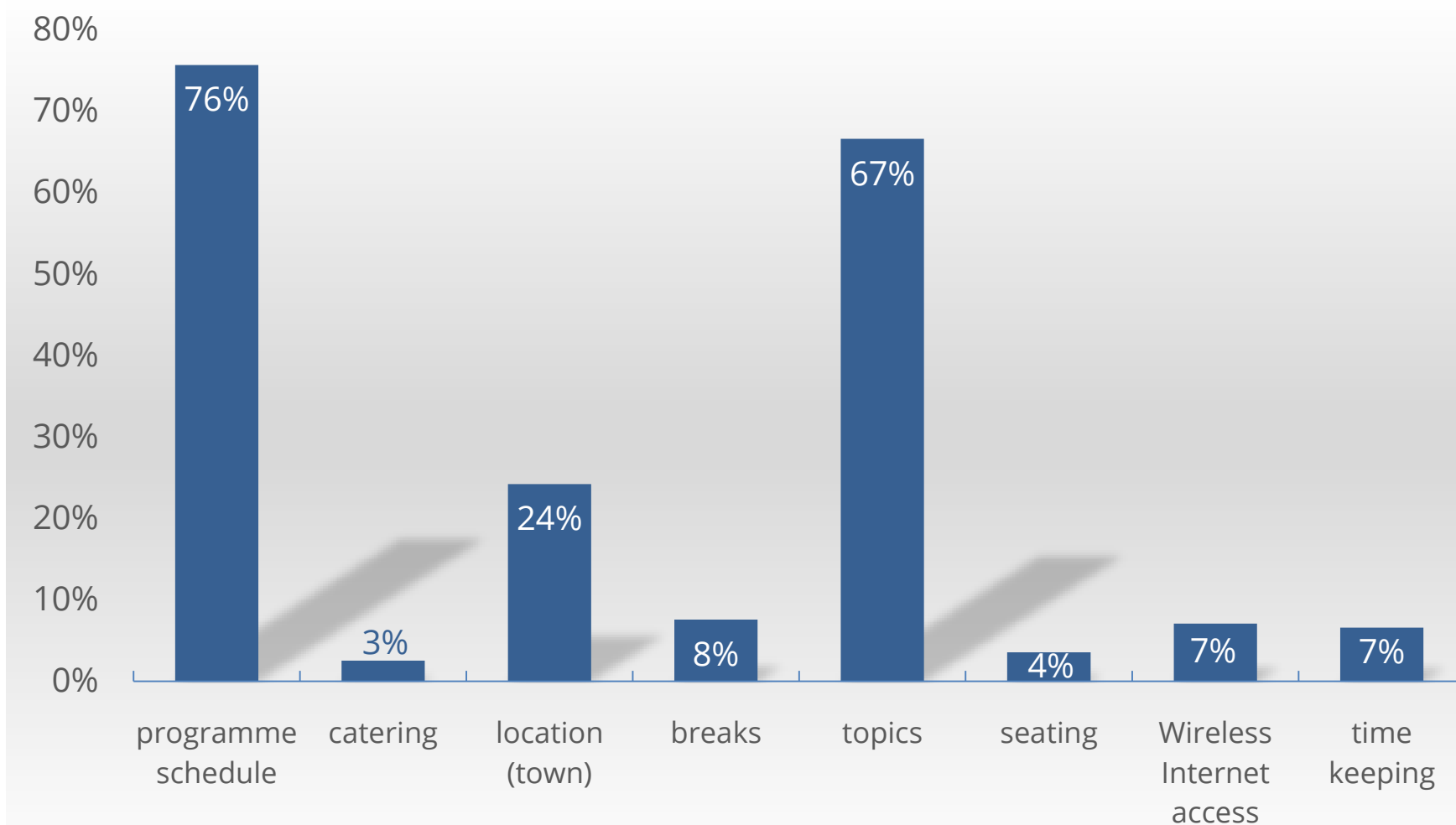


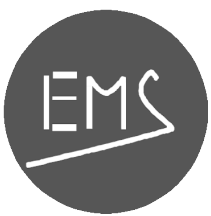
Please rate the general conditions of our event



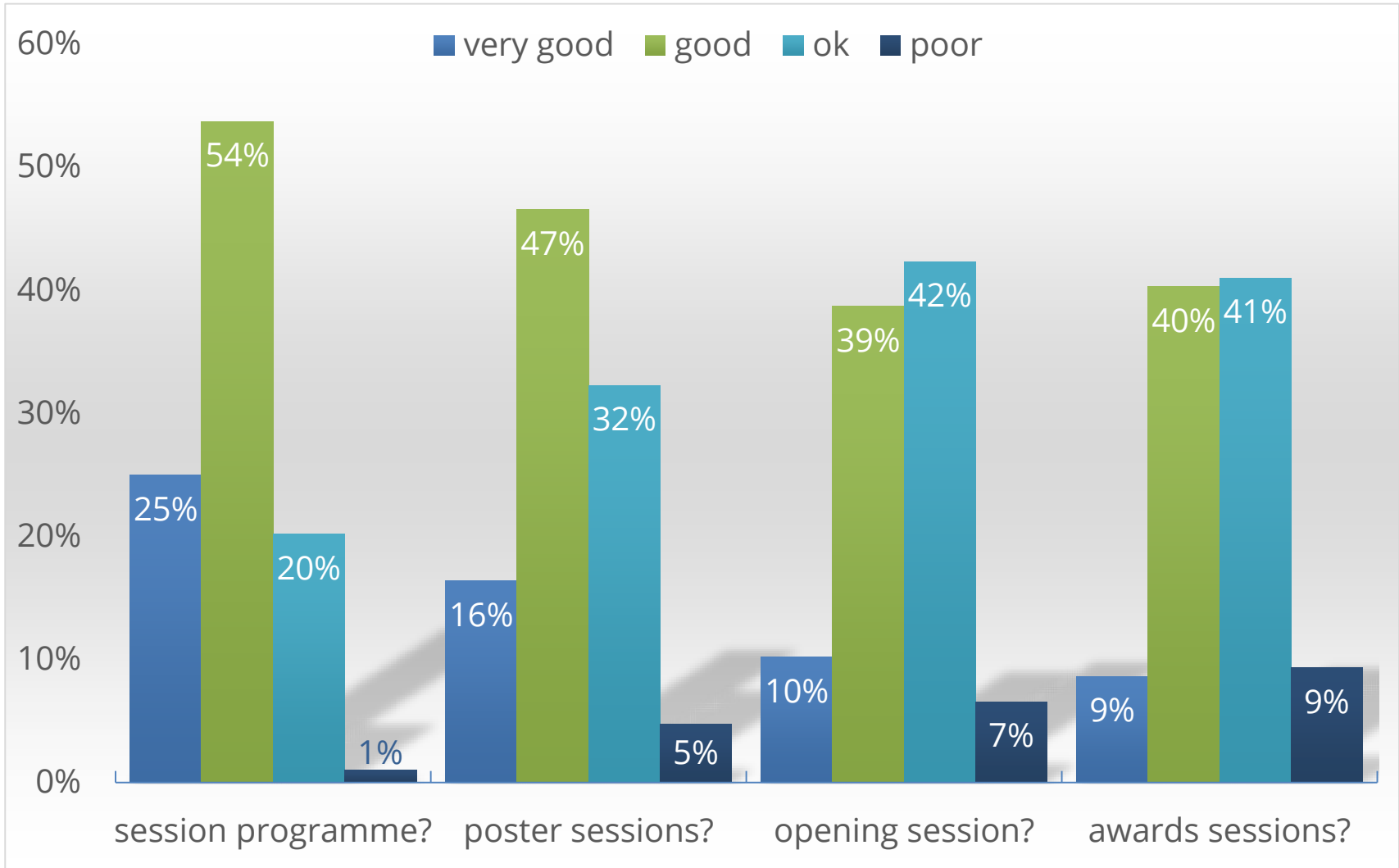


What is most relevant to you during the event? (two answers possible)



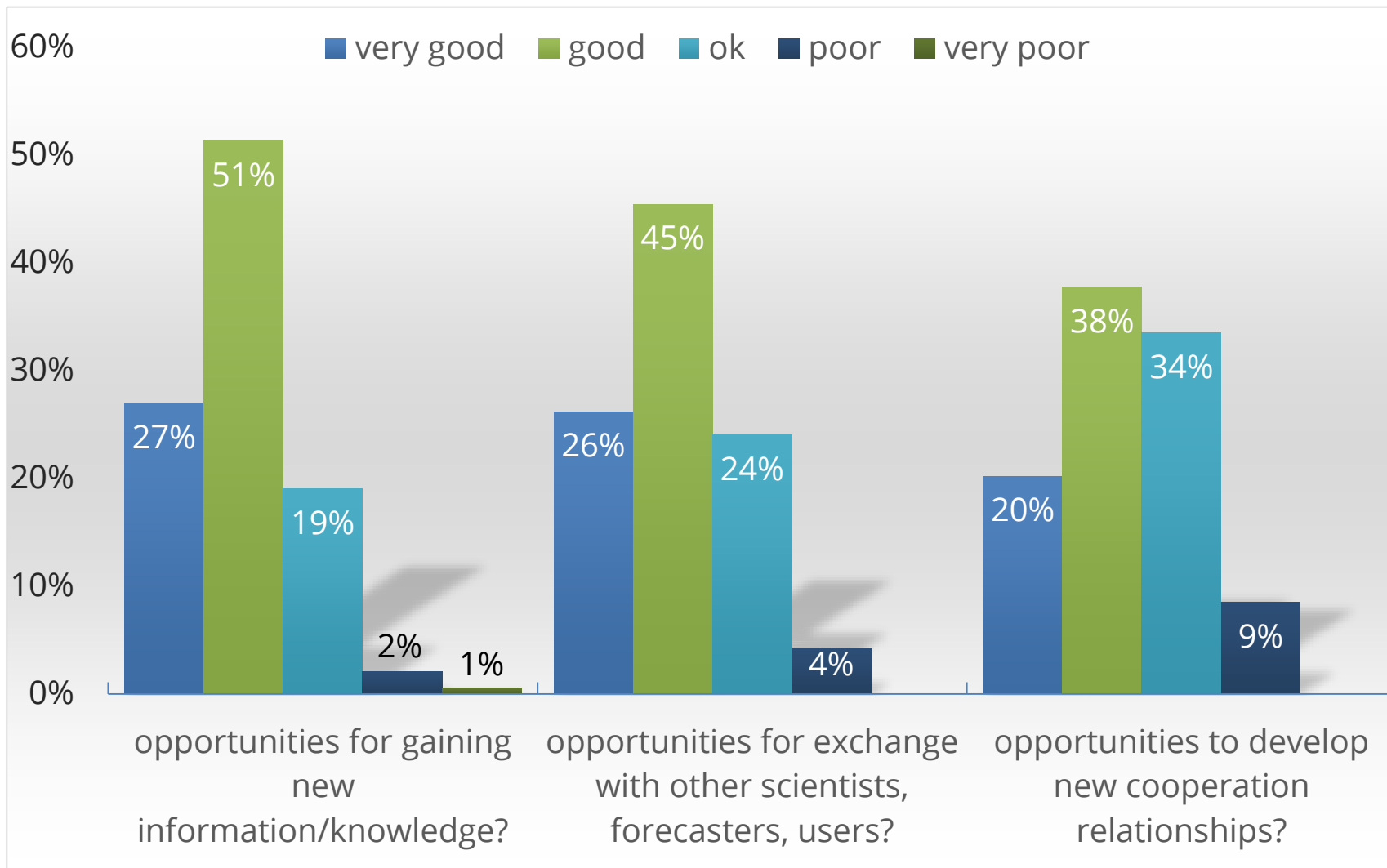

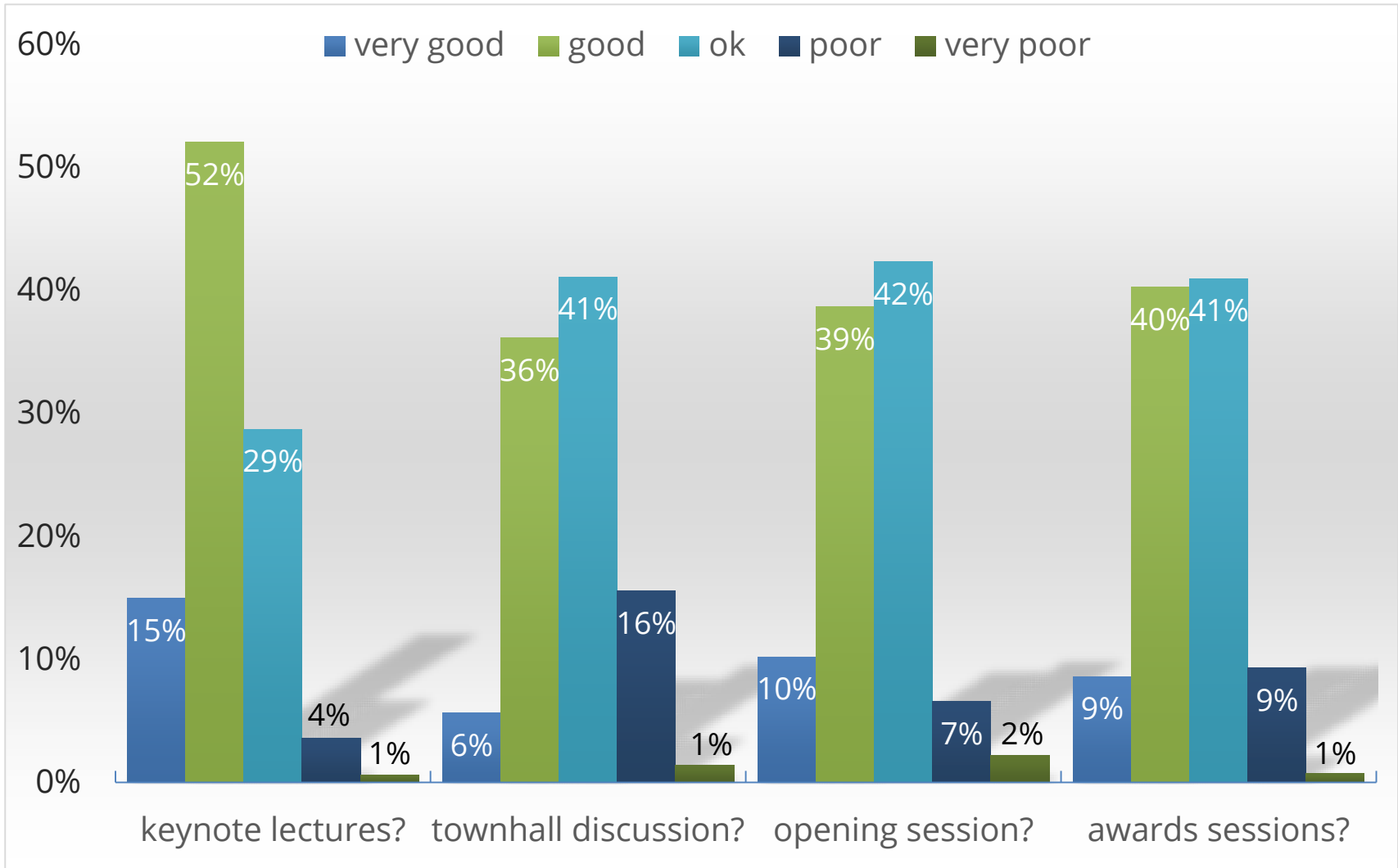


Collaboration & exchange: How do you rate the ...



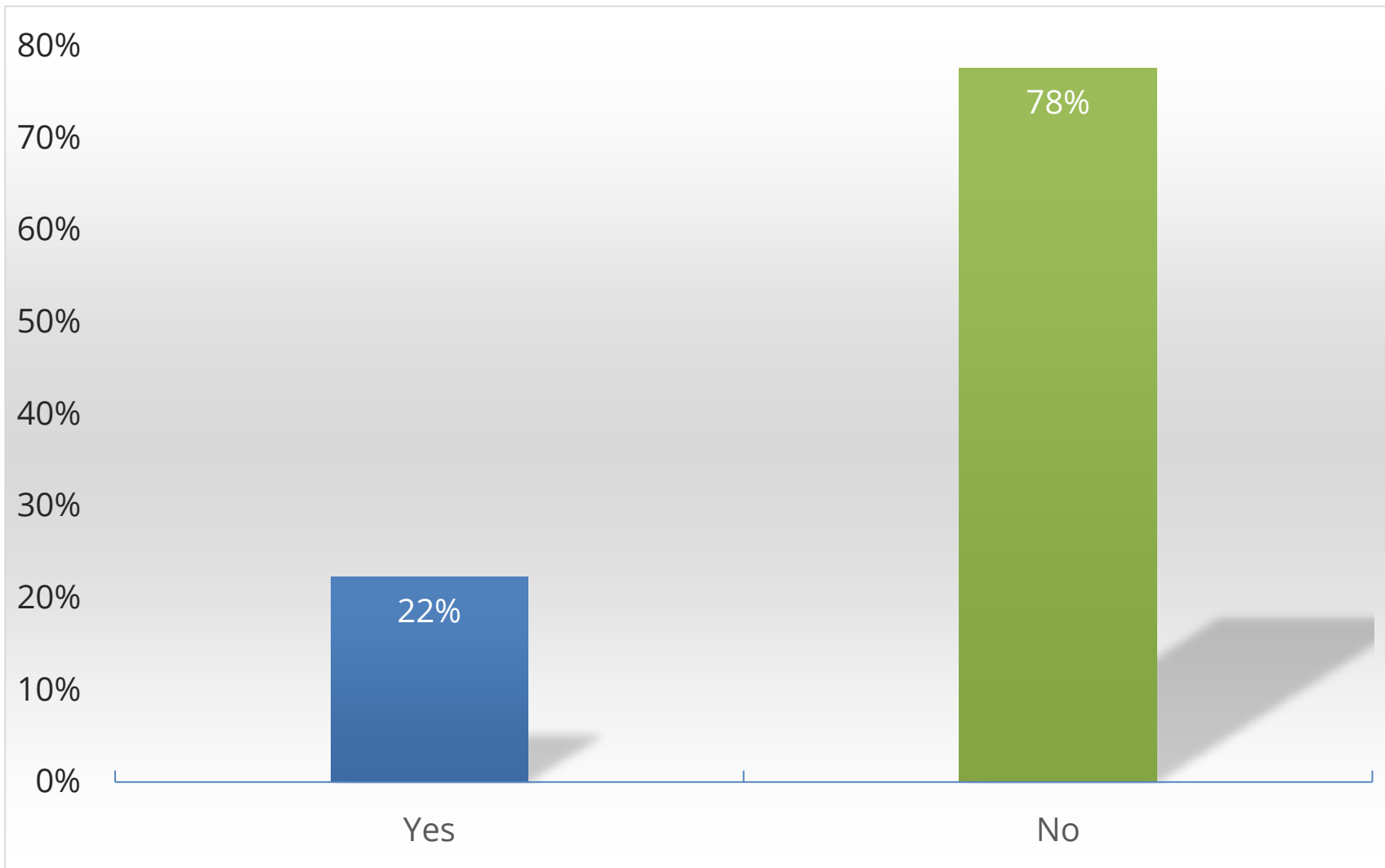

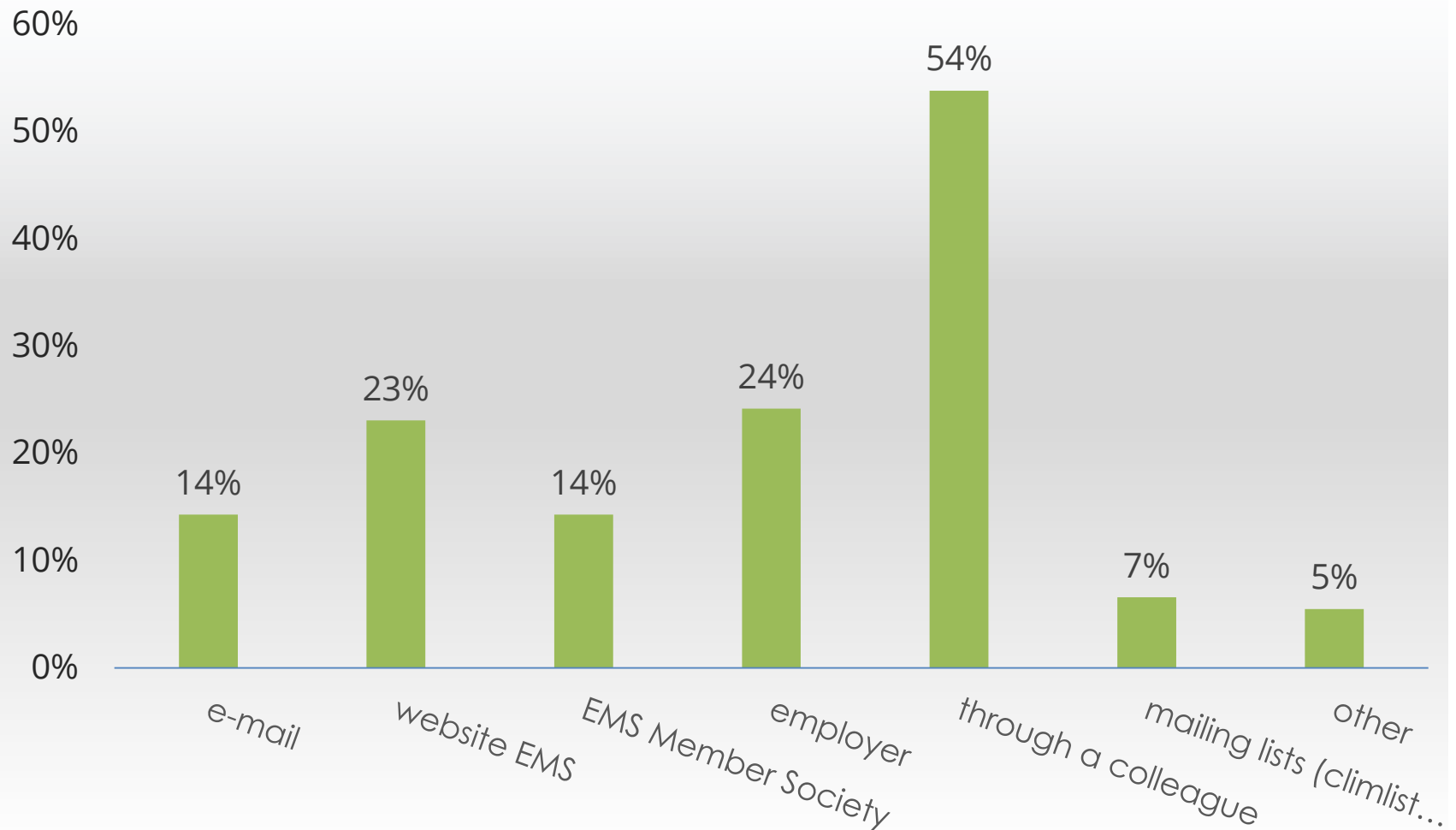


Do you use social media to stay informed during the conference?



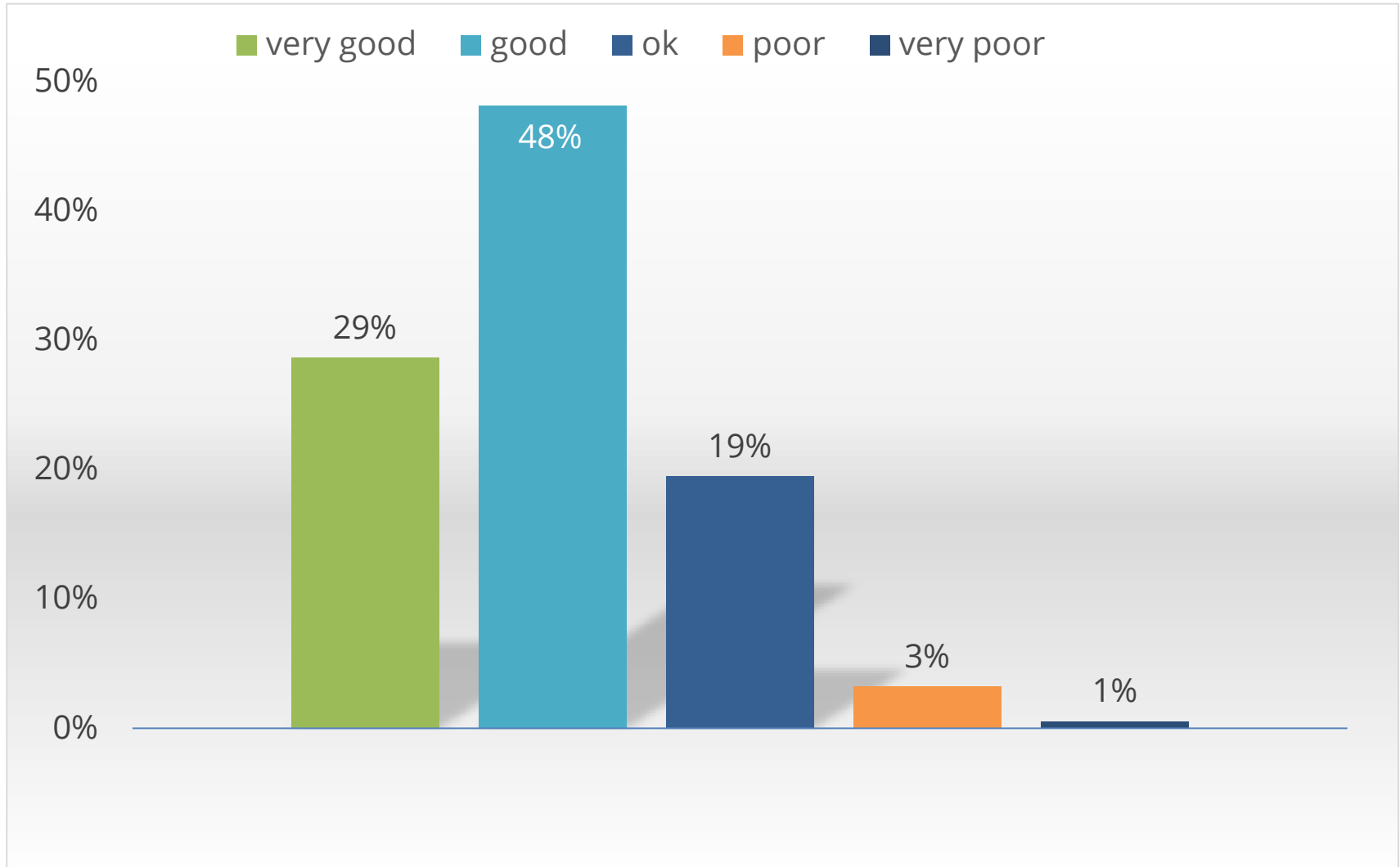


How did you learn about the EMS Annual Meeting 2019?



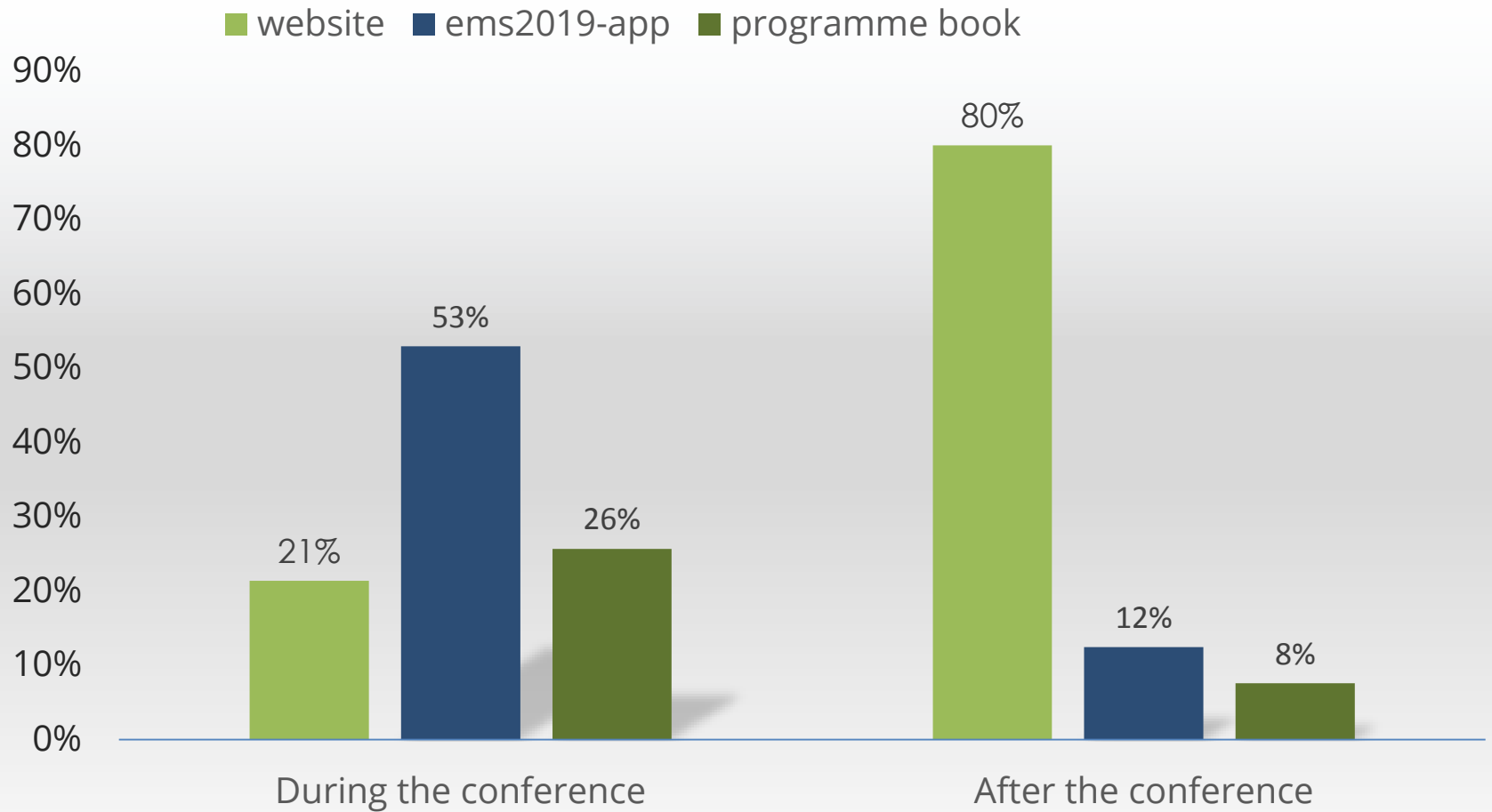


Please rate the information provision through the conference site



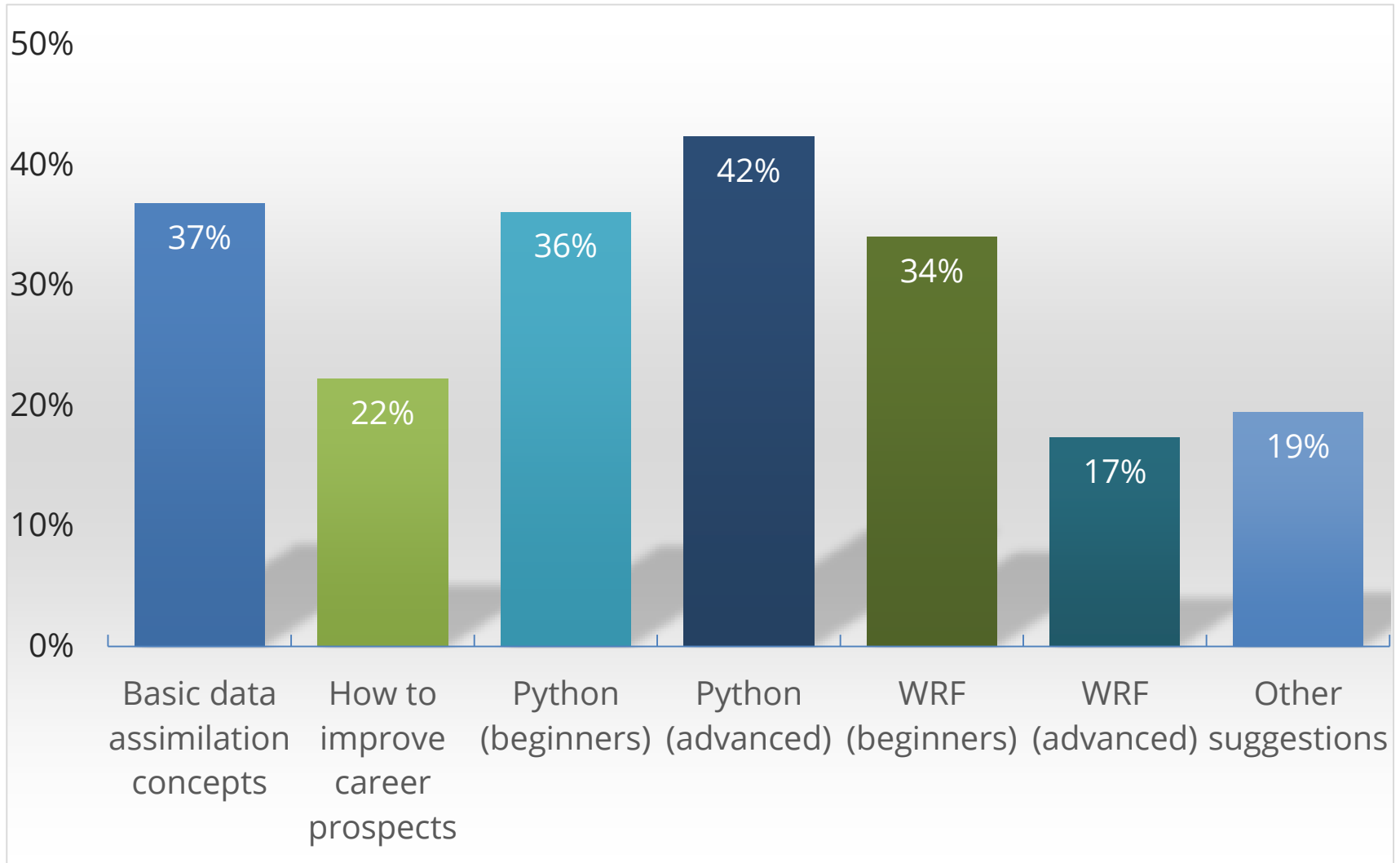


Which is your preferred tool to access information on the programme?



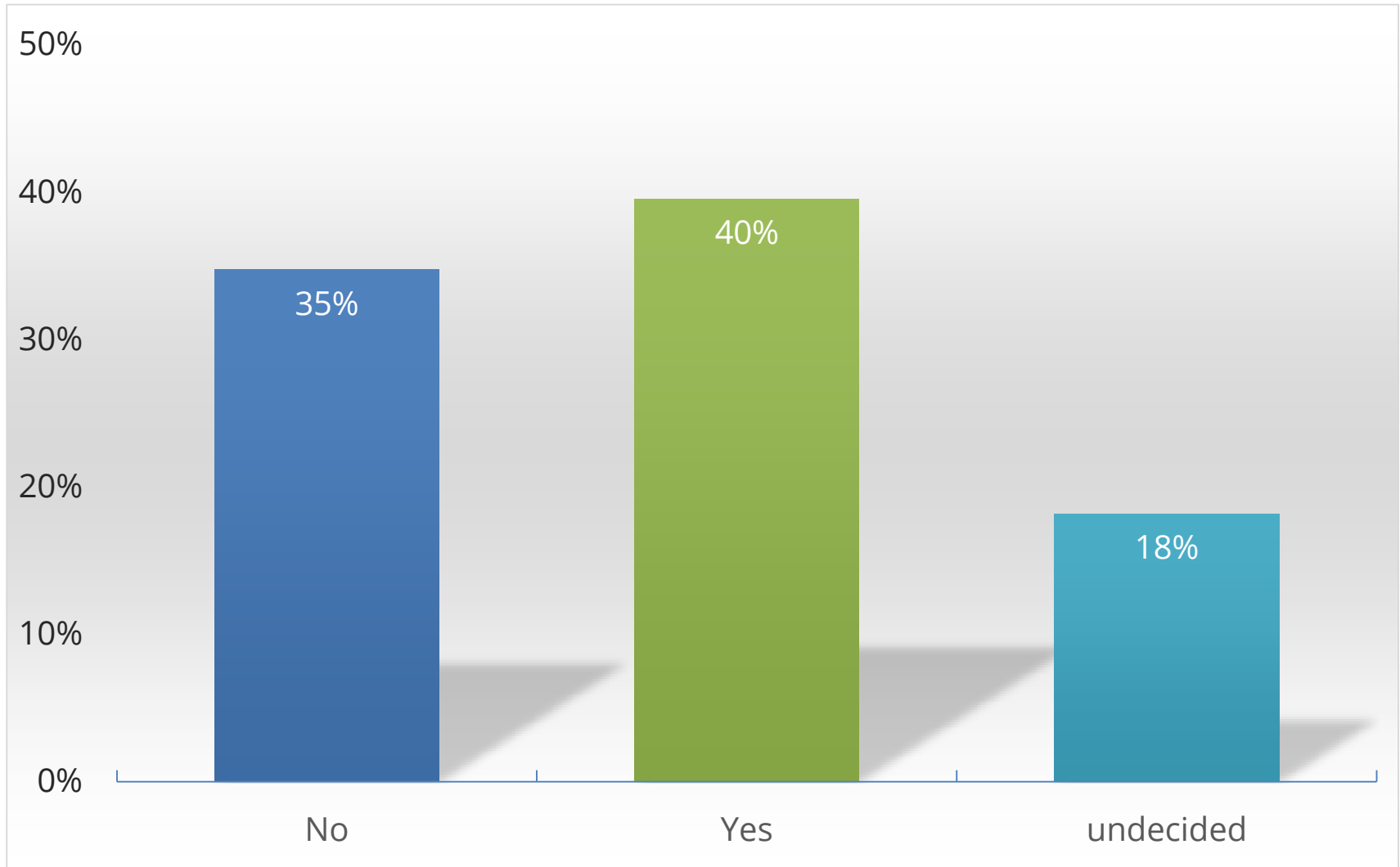

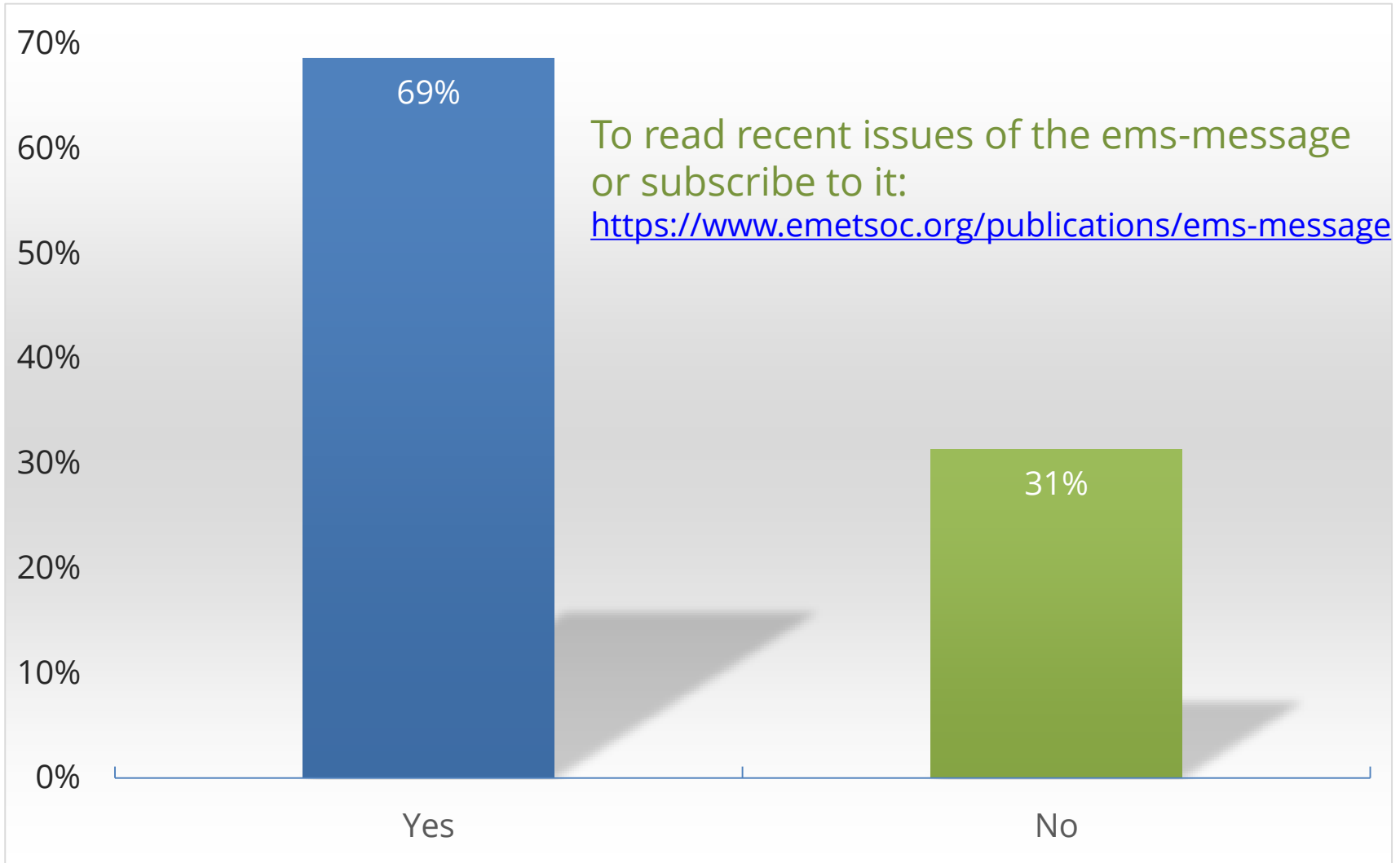


Is the selected town relevant for your decision to attend the EMS Annual Meeting?
